



## **Prevention Specialist**

The Prevention Specialist is primarily responsible for implementing Demand Reduction Programs, such as recruiting male participants and facilitating a curriculum-based support group for male sex buyers. The position will also be responsible for conducting outreach to men and sex buyers.

The position reports to the Strategic Initiatives Manager.

### **Education/Experience:**

Bachelor's degree from an accredited university is required.

Master's degree in Counseling, Social Work, Psychology, or other social sciences strongly preferred.

### **Qualifications:**

1. Minimum 2 years of professional experience in the nonprofit sector and/or social services  
Academic internships can be considered as part of professional experience.
2. Experience with leading and/or participating in Professionally Facilitated support groups
3. Ability to work and interact with diverse groups of people
4. Strong and effective verbal and written communication skills
5. Strong interpersonal skills with the ability to apply compassion and empathy while dealing with stressful and difficult situations
6. Motivated self-starter with the ability to work independently with purpose and efficiency
7. Adaptable working schedule that includes evenings and weekends
8. Organizational skills to coordinate and execute events
9. Proficient computer skills to operate programs (Microsoft Office Suite and PowerPoint)
10. Proven ability to work as a team-player while maintaining positive working relationships
11. Valid driver's license, auto insurance, and reliable personal transportation

### **Responsibilities:**

1. Coordinate and implement Demand Reduction Programs for male sex buyers, including disruption initiatives
2. Facilitate a weekly Demand Reduction curriculum-based support group for male sex buyers
3. Organize bi-monthly operations to disrupt demand for commercial sex acts
4. Develop a program to engage men in the fight against sex and labor trafficking
5. Recruit male participants for Demand Reduction Programs through partnerships with the criminal justice system, law enforcement, and other organizations
6. Facilitate Community Engagement Initiatives at least four times a month to connect with local organizations to inform the public about UAHT's Demand Reduction Initiatives and other programs
7. Assist UAHT staff with special projects on an as needed basis and other duties as assigned by the Strategic Initiatives Manager
