Job Description for the Prevention and Outreach Coordinator

The Prevention and Outreach Coordinator will be primarily responsible for facilitation of our men's accountability stopping sexual exploitation groups and the identification of HT and LT victims through other prevention programs.

SSE is a non-judgmental program based on principles of social justice and personal transformation to help men understand their behavior and promote their own decisions not to buy sex. The Prevention and Outreach Coordinator will support the overall mission of the organization.

Desired Experience and Qualifications:

Education/Experience: Bachelor's degree required and 3-4 years of experience in the non-profit sector and/or social services. A baseline knowledge of human trafficking both globally and locally a plus. Spanish language skills preferred. Male preferred.

This person reports directly to the Director of Prevention

Qualifications:

1. Experienced social worker (LBSW/LMSW) skilled in completing assessments, making referrals, and implementing a plan of care for those engaging in direct services; specifically, men and boys
2. Experienced working with vulnerable populations, i.e., human trafficking victims, undocumented immigrants, homeless populations, individuals involved with the criminal justice system, etc.
3. Proven ability to work as a team-player while maintaining positive and professional working relationships
4. Proficient PC skills such as e-mail, MS office, PowerPoint, salesforce, etc.
5. Valid driver's license, with proof of insurance, and reliable transportation required
6. Must be willing to travel outside of the greater Houston region to support expansion efforts through classes and trainings

Responsibilities:

1. Provide prevention and awareness while utilizing resources that benefit peer support services, such as Stopping Sexual Exploitation, Real Talk and Family Huddle
2. Raise awareness and provide intense groups to individuals with sex purchasing history – this includes networking with local law enforcement, attorney's office as well as other partners and stakeholders in the community, building partnerships, and doing outreach to recruit potential participants, co-facilitators, outside resources for buyers, and more
3. Collaborating and maintaining ongoing peer support network for sex buyers in the Houston area through the SSE development efforts
4. Coordination and facilitation of Stopping Sexual Exploitation Men's accountability program
5. Providing support to male victims identified before, during and after groups have been completed
6. Identifying Human Trafficking victims and referring them to client services case management team
7. Coordination and/or facilitation of Family Huddle Programming; providing support to caregivers and family members of those who have experienced the trauma of HT
8. Coordination and/or facilitation of Real Talk with diverse populations – juvenile detention centers, correctional facilities, rehab facilities
9. Provide innovative ideas of thinking long-term for developing and expanding male specific programs
10. Maintain a working knowledge of significant developments and trends in the field
11. Assist the Prevention Manager with special projects on an as needed basis



General Responsibilities:

Agency Compliance

1. Reports to work consistently and on time; ensures work responsibilities are covered when absent; arrives at meetings and appointments on time
2. Follows instructions; takes responsibility for own actions; keeps commitments; completes tasks on time or notifies appropriate persons with an alternative plan

8. Follows all regulatory requirements for reporting suspected abuse or neglect

1. Balances team and individual responsibilities; exhibits objectivity and openness to others' views
2. Gives and welcomes feedback
3. Inspires and motivates others to perform well; gives appropriate recognition to others
4. Acts respectfully and supportively towards other team members' efforts
5. Accepts responsibility and willingness to be accountable for work product and professional growth
6. Identifies and resolves problems in a timely manner; works well with group problem solving situations; uses reason even when dealing with emotional topics
7. Displays willingness to make decisions; exhibits sound and accurate judgement; supports and explains reasoning for decisions; includes appropriate people in decision-making process; makes timely decisions
